General Exemption

AOC Holders exemption against the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order

1. I, **Marlon Orr**, *Head Flight Operations and Flight Crew Licensing Inspectorate* of the Seychelles Civil Aviation Authority, being a person authorised in that behalf by the Minister under the Civil Aviation (Amendment) Regulations, 2007, by virtue of the Article 87 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order (CAP31), hereby exempt:
 - (a) **All Air Operator Certificate (AOC) holders from the above provisions of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order to the extent that provisions of JAR-OPS 1 and 3 apply.**

2. This exemption becomes valid as of **01st June 2011**
