

Foreword

1 Purpose and scope

Airworthiness Notices are issued by the Seychelles Civil Aviation Authority (SCAA) to circulate information, procedure and policy to all concerned with the airworthiness of civil aircraft in the Seychelles.

The Airworthiness Notices are published in support of the discretionary powers of the SCAA as stated in Regulation 6 (6)(d) of the CIVIL AVIATION (SAFETY) REGULATIONS, 2017 as amended.

The SCAA shall make reference to the Airworthiness Notices when exercising its discretionary powers to ensure an effective implementation of the International Civil Aviation Organisation standards contained in the Annexes of the Chicago Convention.

2 Publication and Distribution

It is the policy of the SCAA that published Airworthiness Notices shall be distributed free of charge on its official website at www.scaa.sc.

The list of all Airworthiness Notices is published on the SCAA official website as a table, which gives particulars of all current Notices, such as reference number, title, revision number, issue date and a hyperlink to their content.

When a procedure or policy, which has already been the subject of a Notice, is changed, the relevant Notice is re-issued under the same number with a new revision number and issue date. The old issue is deleted.

The cancellation of a Notice will be indicated in the contents list by the deletion of all details except for the number. The title of the Notice will be replaced with the word "cancelled".

3 Notice revision

This Notice becomes effective from the date of issue and supersedes Airworthiness Notice No. 1 issue 4, dated June 2011, which should be destroyed.
