**Civil Aviation Directive:**  
*Maintenance Organisation Approval*

**GENERAL**

Civil Aviation (Safety) Regulations, 2017, regulation 110 empowers the Authority to issue civil aviation directives on the matters which are prescribed by regulations.

**PURPOSE**

Document SCAA CAD-AIRW/11 contains the technical standards, rules, requirements, methods, specifications, characteristics and procedures which are applicable in respect of the *Approval of Maintenance Organisations*.

**APPLICABILITY**

Civil Aviation (Safety) Regulations, 2017, regulation 11.

**INCORPORATION OF INTERNATIONAL AVIATION STANDARDS**

Civil Aviation (Safety) Regulations, 2017, regulation 110 empowers the Authority to incorporate by reference into a directive, any international aviation standard.

The international aviation standard known as "European Aviation Safety Agency, Part-145 (dated 26<sup>th</sup> November 2014)", as applicable to the *Approval for the Maintenance of Aircraft and Components*, is incorporated into the technical standards contained in this document, as amended.

**DIRECTIVE**

It is hereby directed that the requirements to be met by an organization to qualify for an approval to maintain aircraft and components, are those laid down in the EASA Part-145, inclusive of all associated AMC and AGM, (as defined by the EASA) except as provided for below.

**COMMENCEMENT**

This Directive shall come into force on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2017.

**EXCEPTIONS**
