Civil Aviation Directive:
Authority Requirements for Air Operations

GENERAL

Civil Aviation (Safety) Regulations, 2017, Regulation 110, empowers the Authority to issue civil aviation directives on the matters which are prescribed by regulations.

PURPOSE

Document SCAA CAD-OPS/106 contains the conditions and technical standards pertaining to authority requirements for air operations.

APPLICABILITY

Civil Aviation (Safety) Regulations, 2017, Part 8, Regulation 106.

INCORPORATION OF INTERNATIONAL AVIATION STANDARDS

Civil Aviation (Safety) Regulations, 2017 Regulation 110, empowers the Authority to prescribe conditions and technical standards relating to any national or international aviation standard.

The international aviation standards contained in "European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) Part-ARO", as amended, is incorporated into the technical standards contained in this document.

DIRECTIVE

It is hereby directed that Authority requirements pertaining to Air Operations shall conform to the technical standards of EASA Part-ARO inclusive of the associated Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC) and Guidance Material (GM) except as provided for below.

COMMENCEMENT

This Directive shall come into force on 9th May 2018.
