SUBJECT:	SEYCHELLES CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY (AERODROME) ORDERS 2010 – AMENDMENT No. 1	

This is to inform you that there has been two minor amendments to the ‘Seychelles Civil Aviation Authority (Aerodrome) Orders 2010’ which takes immediate effect. This has been necessary to address two technicalities which were not legally covered in the original wording.

The amendments are as follows:-

Order 43 Stopping under wing, etc., of aircraft.

43. No driver of any vehicle in the movement area shall draw up or stop the vehicle under the wing, tail or fuselage of an aircraft **except for the purpose of ground handling, servicing, maintenance, refueling or other purposes as shall be approved by the aircraft operator or by the SCAA.**

The part in red has been added to allow handling and maintenance activities to be covered by the orders.

Order 75 Use of mobile phones on movement areas

75. No person shall carry a mobile phone **that is switched on or on stand-by within twelve (12) metres of any refueling vehicle which is at the time engaged in aircraft refueling.**

The part in red has been added for practical reasons to allow a person to carry a mobile phone that has been switched off during refueling.
